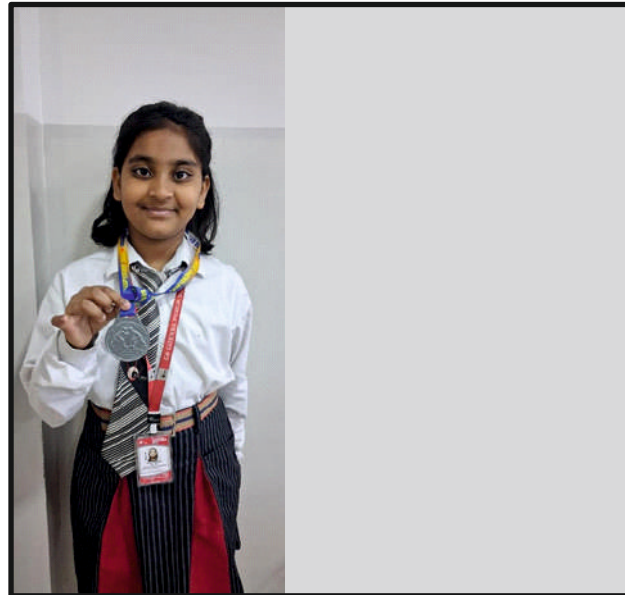

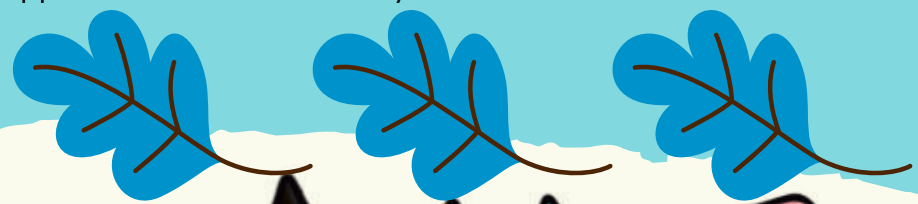
## INTER HOUSE BASKETBALL COMPETITION (11.10.25)

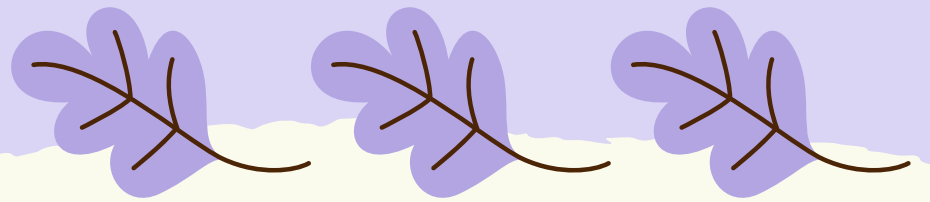

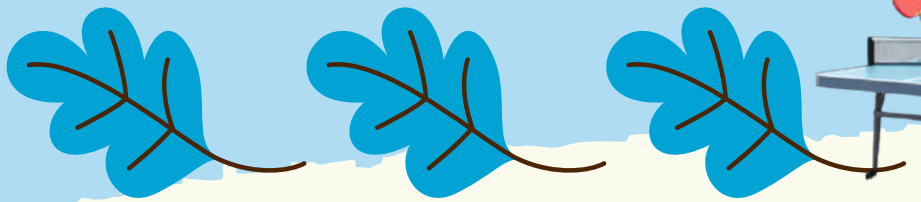
## DIWALI CELEBRATION (17.10.25)

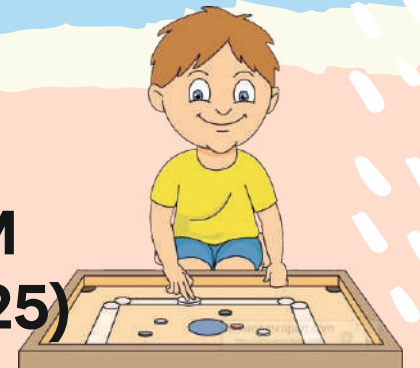
## INTER HOUSE TABLE TENNIS COMPETITION (25.10.25)

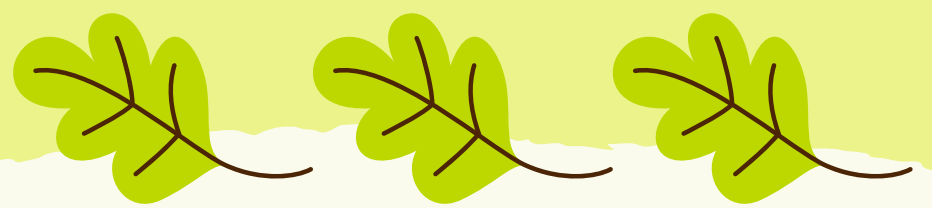

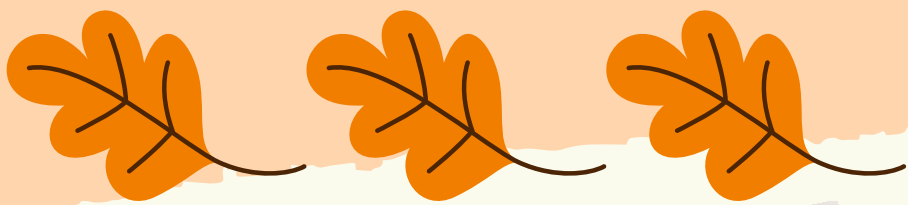
## GREEN DAY CELEBRATION (29.10.25)

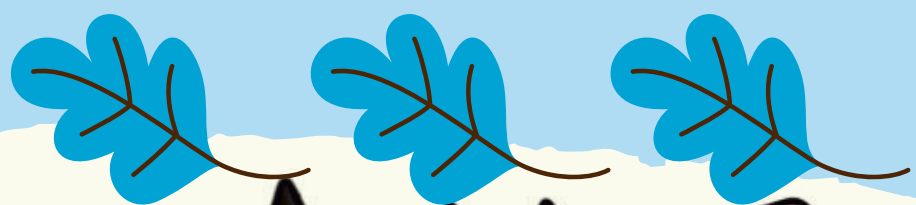
## ORANGE DAY (29.10.25)

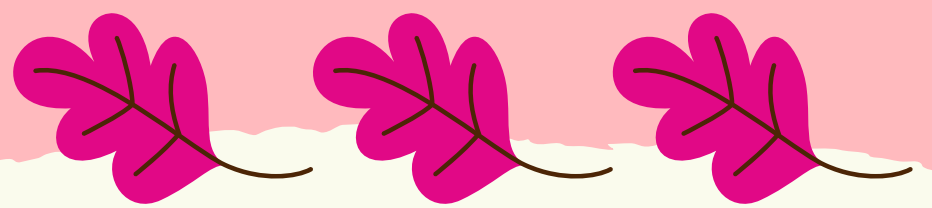

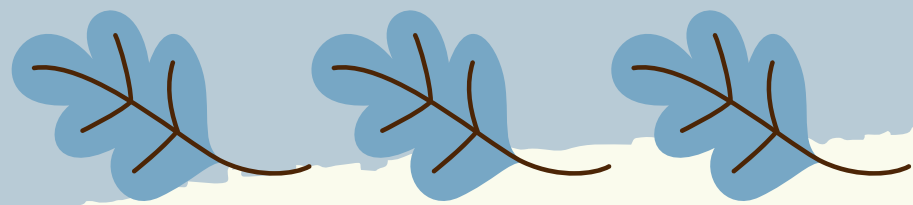
## ENGLISH ELOCUTION (28.10.25) (THEME – INDEPENDENCE DAY)
